Dear Ivy Towne North Neighborhood Association Member/Concerned Citizen,

On April 1, 2004, Association members presented arguments to the Safety Advisory Commission, regarding the installation of 2 additional stop signs at the intersection of J Street and Drexel Drive (*See attachment*).

There are several problems with the data the City of Davis collected. Therefore, the Commission requested that the City of Davis address the intersection once again. Specifically, they were asked to recalculate their traffic flow volumes to include bicycle traffic. Line of site calculations were to be recalculated from the perspective of a car or bicycle entering J Street from Drexel Drive. Pending the City's revision, the matter was continued to the May 6, 2004 Safety Advisory Commission meeting.

This meeting is at 5p.m., in the Community Chambers, located behind City Hall.
