



## **SMUD to share Yolo annexation plans**

SACRAMENTO - The SMUD board is hosting a public workshop to discuss the economic benefits that officials say Sacramento County customers would reap under a plan to annex eastern Yolo County.

Expanding across the Sacramento River would generate benefits totaling more than \$110 million over 20 years for current customers, officials at the Sacramento Municipal Utility District said. The move would create a larger customer base to spread overhead costs, keeping rates low for Sacramento County residents, officials said.

The meeting also will provide an update on natural gas prices and the regulatory process under way by the Sacramento Local Agency Formation Commission. LAFCO is reviewing SMUD's proposal to annex Davis, Woodland, West Sacramento and adjacent unincorporated area.
