The Band Booster Newsletter



The **Band Trip** this year (May, 2008) is to Victoria, British Columbia. New regulations require that every person returning from Canada to the US have a valid passport.

There are no exceptions. If a student does not have a passport he or she will not be able to participate in this trip, which is a fabulous experience. If your student already has a passport, please confirm that it will be valid for several months after May 2008 (there can reportedly be issues if one travels with a passport close to expiration).

If your student does not have a passport, please apply for one right away. Application forms are at the Post Office. Passport pictures can be taken at a number of locations (the Post Office, Longs, Kinkos, PostMark's, Costco, etc.) It appears to be taking two months for the application to be processed.
