Normally this is the time when I rehash of our Winter Concert -- extolling the talents of our students and generally patting ourselves on the back. It actually was a wonderful performance by some really great students. Who can forget the smooth cohesive sound of our Concert Band? The electricity of the first notes of the Symphonic Band's "Coventry Variant?" . the mastery of Jane Seo's flute performance, and the warm feelings of our Combined Bands - first by the fantastic sound of over 150 band students, alumni and parents playing the traditional Holiday songs and concluding with the moving performance of "Auld Lang Syne." Where else can you see a parent and child playing together in harmonious joy? This part of our performance brought a lump to my throat. Did it have the same effect on you? Hope so! Anyway, I'm alad I won't need to rehash this --- oops I think just did!

I hope this was a special time for you and your family.

But, 'nough said - time to look at what's coming in 2009!

First we have the **Folsom Jazz Festival** (January 24) for our great jazz musicians. We don't have any official information on this yet, but the tentative schedule has the combo playing at 7:30 a.m, and the Big Band playing at 3:25 (note: this is subject to change). That same weekend we have the **Playathon** (January 24-25) - the band's all-night party and play session. Encourage your student to get lots of pledges in order to make this event profitable as well as fun.

The Jazz Band plays for the Jazz Choir **Cabaret** on February 7 and 8. Times will be announced a bit later. The **Festivity of Bands** is scheduled for February 18 with UCD and CSUS - this year we get the opportunity to host the event in our own IPAB. This is a great chance to see 3 very talented groups and to compare the work of our high school students with that of the colleges. If you've never seen this event, I think you would be very favorably impressed.

The **Coconut Grove** (February 28) - our signature event with a performances by the Emerson and Harper Jazz Ensembles as well as our own big band and a return performance by the DHS Jazz Choir.

Oh yeah - lots on **Pep Band at the Basketball games**. Sam has sent out a list of dates and hopes there will be lots of support for our boys and girls teams.

You'd think we could relax soon, wouldn't you? Well we don't!!!

March kicks things up a notch (BAM!) with our very own **Golden Empire Festival** on Thursday, March 19th. This will be a unique event held in our IPAB, with an adjudicator joining us for the whole day, working with our Jazz Band and Concert Band during the day, and both Concert and Symphonic Bands performing in the evening and actually continuing their judging right in front of the audience.

March concludes with a **Jazz Concert** (March 29) with our own big band and the Capitol Jazz Project. This is the fourth time we have been able to host this great ensemble and is always a chance to learn about the world of jazz.

I'm not going to get into April and May right now - I'm tired just thinking about all we have planned for January, February and March. I hope you will try to attend all (or most) of these events.

(Boy, am I glad I didn't need to rehash the Winter Concert!)

Again, aren't you glad your students are spending so much of their spare time in such a wholesome activity as band?

### DHS BANDS - 2009 SAN DIEGO SPRING TOUR Fri. May 15 – Tues. May 19 **First Payment Request**

Dear Band Families.

A reminder that, as stated in the December letter sent home to families regarding this year's band trip, the initial payment of \$250 for the DHS Band trip to San Diego is due January 16th.

#### **Trip Cost**

The final cost of the trip is still to be determined but will likely be between \$475 and \$550 per student. Payments will be made in 3 installments, starting January 16th. Every student who wishes to attend this trip will be able to participate. Financial assistance is available. Please contact Mr. Lange directly, at this time, if you would like to request financial assistance. Band Boosters has allocated some funds for student assistance, and all requests will be strictly confidential, between Mr. Lange and the family only.

<u>Fundraising Opportunities</u> Students have already begun adding to their individual band accounts from the fall fundraisers – car washes, Natsoulas Festival raffle, Entertainment Book sales and the holiday Rent a Band ensembles. Upcoming fundraising opportunities include the Play-a-thon at the end of January, the Coconut Grove in February, and our spring car washes. Your student can significantly lower the cost of the trip by participating in these fundraisers.

#### **Payment Schedule:**

Jan 16: \$250 trip deposit due. This deposit is non-refundable, since we will be using the funds collected in January to pay the bill for the hotel immediately. We realize that finances are difficult for many families especially just after the holidays, but we need our final count for hotel rooms so you must sign up and send a deposit by Jan 16<sup>th</sup> to secure a spot for your child.

#### March 6: 2<sup>nd</sup> payment due - \$150.

April date TBD: Final payment will be calculated individually for each student. It will depend on the final trip cost, less any money the student has earned in their individual band account.

#### The meeting was called to order at 7:36pm

I. The minutes from the November meeting were approved as printed in the Band Booster Newsletter.

II. Music Director's report – Mr. Lange reports that the two concerts last month went well. John Philip Sousa was a big hit at the Symphonic band concert. The Winter Rhapsody on Thursday 12/18 will be the last concert this year. Parents who attend rehearsals are invited to play in the concert.

III. Treasurer's report – Treasurer Jo Andrews Merges clarified that expenses for CD and DVD sales are fronted from the general fund. Direct Donations are initially deposited into the general fund until we track where funds are designated. John Horn will be working with Jo on payments for the San Diego trip. The company for the Entertainment books hasn't been paid yet. Janet Matlock can confirm the amount owed them. To date there is about \$7200 in the general fund. The music program fund has a little over \$2000 not including gate collections from the last concerts. We are doing fine financially at this time. We have a reserve account of \$15,000. Parents should get in contact with Mr. Lange if they need financial assistance for San Diego trip.

#### IV. Committee reports-

A. Student report – Sam Bold shares Pep Band basketball season gets started in January. He will print a schedule of which games the Pep Band will play in the January newsletter. Games usually are from 7:30-9pm and are 30 points each.

B. Car wash -The DJUSD parking lot has been reserved for two car washes in the spring.

C. Direct Donations – Joyce Hamaguchi reports that to date we have received donations from 52 donors for \$6461. We have another week left in the fund raiser. Another letter will go out to families reminding people to please make a donation. A motion was made to give \$5000 to the music program fund at this date and was approved by member vote. Next month we will determine if more money needs to be allocated to the music program fund. Mr. Lange plans to use the money on the purchase of an oboe and percussion repairs.

D. Rent-a-Band – Mr. Lange says the four directors are doing a fantastic job - Robbie, Diego, Christine, and Emma. There are lots of requests for solo pianists. Lots of parents have been helping with driving. The Hatamiyas are doing an excellent job of organizing events.

E. Playathon- Plans are going ahead with the event. Pledge forms were made available to all students. The Jazz Band students and Mr. Lange will arriving just on-time as they will be coming from the Folsom Jazz Festival

F. Coconut Grove- The same set of core volunteers will be helping with the event this year. The same bands are participating this year as well. There will be a raffle of a Wii. The planning committee can always use more volunteers. Contact Randy Chinn if you are interested in helping with this event.

G. San Diego trip- A letter was sent home with all students announcing the trip. The first payment is due mid-January. We are finalizing details and the itinerary. We are requesting a parent volunteer to be a trip doctor.

H. Concerts – For the combined band concert Peggy Bernardy will get flowers for Jane and Mr. Lange. Refreshments and CD/DVD's will be sold. We will be asking for donations for all concerts this school year. Clark Bryant emailed that the district fee for using the IPAB has been waived.

J. Others-The Yogurt Shack evening brought in \$210.64. We have asked for another date in the Spring. Lamppost Pizza brought in around \$100. The next pizza night will be in February. The final accounting of the Entertainment Books has not yet been done. The book itself is not that great, and working with the management has been difficult so it was recommended that we drop this particular fundraiser. We will discuss this in more detail when we plan fundraising for next year.

V. Old Business -

A. DHS BB Bylaws Proposal – We will continue to work on it.

VI. New Business – We may need a new publicity chair at some point. Past President and Treasurer binders will be stored in water-tight plastic tubs at DHS under the stage. The Jazz Band and Capital Jazz Project concert is scheduled for 3/29/09.
