Supporting the Davis High School Concert, Symphonic, Jazz and Pep Bands



It was a dark and stormy night. Suddenly a pirate ship appeared on the horizon! (I bet I have your attention...) Meanwhile, in Davis, California, the high school band was holding their Playathon. (I know I have your attention now!)

The annual Playathon, actually the 22nd Annual Playathon, will take place on the weekend of January 23-24 in the MPR at DHS. This event has become a favorite of our students as they play and party their way through 12 hours of fun.

And why do they do this??? Well, for each of the past 3 years, the students have managed to amass over \$8,000 in pledges for their individual accounts. Each and every penny they manage to raise goes directly into their account for the band trip. Oh, and incidentally, they have a huge amount of fun, food and friendship all night long.

The evening begins with an informal concert by the Concert, Symphonic, and Jazz Bands. We call this a "Concert in Progress," as none of the groups have managed to perfect any of the works they are currently working on. Next we have a period of guest conductors and guest performers taken from members of the band family and local dignitaries.

The period from 12:00 midnight to 6:00 a.m. is reserved just for the band students to sight-read (Continued on page 2)

Not so fast!

First, each hour of playing is actually only 45 minutes long (because each hour includes a 15 minute "party break") and the students are allowed to take one hour off out of every three to "rest & recuperate." Note: most students choose not to rest during those hours off – there is too much food, pizza, drinks, and friends – basically PARTYING – to rest. Now the best part – all of this takes place on the weekend after finals so they have all day on Sunday and Monday to rest for the start of classes on Tuesday.





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Band Booster Minutes ~ December 2, 2009



- I. **Approval of Minutes** The minutes from the November 2009 meeting as printed in the newsletter were unanimously approved.
- II. Music Director's report Mr. Lange reports that the students did a fantastic job at the two concerts in November. The Symphonic and Concert Bands will be performing at the Winter Rhapsody Concert on December 17th. A number of parents will be performing with the bands that evening. The Jazz Band will be performing in the Delta Jazz Festival in Stockton on December 5th.
- III. Student report Pep Band leader, Naomi E., announced the Pep Band will be starting again in January for men's and women's basketball. They will play at 5 games this season. The game dates will be coming out on the calendar. The last Friday in January is "break the record" night. Students in Symphonic Band may volunteer to participate in a Secret Santa program.
- IV. Treasurer's report There is nothing significant to report.

V. Committee reports

- A. Pizza and Yogurt Habit Burger brought in \$138. Yoloberry will be contacting us with a date for a fundraiser. We are trying to coordinate the date with a concert. The next LampPost Pizza date will be February 17th, 2010.
- B. Direct Donations We have collected just short of \$11,000 so far.
- C. **Rent-a-Band** Maki says we would like to have more gigs. There are about 10 gigs scheduled so far. If students have participated in rehearsals, they may sign up for a gig on the sheets in the band room. Any student wanting to perform must submit field trip paperwork promptly. There are Rent-a-Band flyers available to pass around. Please contact Maki if your student wants to participate in a gig but is never assigned to a gig.
- D. **Playathon** Sandra Weisker is creating the sign-up forms for the event. The past two years the band had t-shirts. We may consider pajama pants. Dottie Egel is willing to coordinate this. Chris Weisker and John Cargyle will be directing the band.
- E. **Coconut Grove** All attention is being focused on finding volunteers. Last year we had 480 hours of student help. We rely on our students to help out with a lot of the work. The junior high bands will be encouraged to perform at the event.
- F. **Concerts, CD/DVD sales** The Jazz Band concert brought in \$1,400 and the Symphonic Band brought in \$1,300 at their November concerts. The DVDs and CDs are available for pick up. Tom Estes has been paid for his services.
- G. **Disneyland trip** John Horn says the next trip meeting is Thursday December 10th. The busses and hotel have been reserved. We have a variety of playing opportunities. Disneyland will confirm playing times. Peter is coordinating a possible workshop for the combined band with UC Irvine. There is another person at USC who is willing to work with the bands. Details will be finalized in the next couple of months.
- H. Scrip Lynne Rumery is trying to promote the program a bit. The DHS Bands have been registered for a great scrip program for 3% at SaveMart. Lynne will distribute the scrip cards at a future concert.
- I. Others John Horn will bring the idea to Naomi about having a DHS casual band shirt.

VI. Old Business

A. BB volunteers still needed for several smaller time-limited jobs. A very specific description of what help is needed would make it so much easier for people to say yes.

VII. New Business

Possible DHS regulations on all Booster clubs – A few of the BB officers met with the DJUSD finance officer and the DHS principal regarding new regulations for any Booster clubs in the Davis school district.
