## ♪ Band Director's Message ♪

A question to ponder... *If a tuba falls in the middle of a holiday band concert and there is no audience to hear it, are the saxophones still out of tune?*

This past month there were two fantastic performances by our Symphonic and Jazz Bands. While there were appreciative audiences, I couldn't help but wonder why so few parents came to support their students. I think there was plenty of advance notice, including articles in the newsletter. We were performing in the new theater and had two amazing soloists, Julie Hochman and Eric Burger. The programs were very interesting -- an ELECTRIC TROMBONE!— certainly not your usual high school band fare. Still, I would venture that fewer than half the band families attended these performances.

Well, you all have a chance to redeem yourselves. On Thursday, December 16th at 7:30 p.m., the Symphonic and Concert Bands will present their "Winter Rhapsody" concert, featuring selections sure to put you in the holiday mood. The concert will be the first performance this year by our Concert Band. Selections will include a stirring march - "Silvercrest," a double fugue by Bach, and "Overture to a Winter Celebration" – a medley of holiday tunes. A highlight of the Symphonic Band presentation will be the performance of "Rhapsody for Flute and Band" by Stephen Bulla, featuring flute soloist Christine Chu. Now a senior, Christine has been an integral part of our Symphonic Band

### **Planning a holiday party for your home or business?**

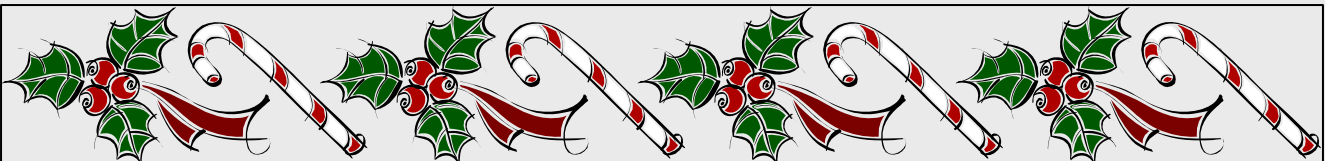

# Play-a-Thon is Coming!

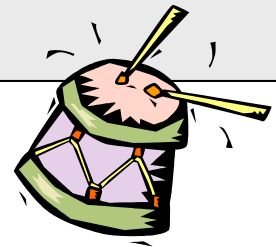

## ♪ Band Booster Minutes ~ November 10, 2010 ♪

The meeting was called to order at 7:31 p.m.



**Approval of Minutes** - The October minutes as published by Joyce Boulanger in the November newsletter were unanimously approved.

**Music Director's Report** - Mr. Lange got his flu shot today. The Symphonic Band will be performing "Legends and Scoundrels" with guest Julie Hochman on Monday evening, and the Jazz Band concert is on Friday evening with Davis High alumni, Eric Burger. A \$300 honorarium will be given to both guests, Julie Hochman on cello and Eric Burger on electric trombone, and a \$100 to the English horn player hired to perform with the Symphonic Band. Jazz Band will be traveling to the Delta Jazz Festival in Stockton the first weekend in December. Parents and friends are encouraged to perform with the Concert and Symphonic Bands at the Winter Concert. If you want to participate, please send Mr. Lange an email requesting music. The new sousaphone and thunder sheet have arrived. The band students will not be giving the usual performance for the junior high students on Monday afternoon.

**Student's Report** - Pep Band - There is a movement to have some students show up as peppy people with instruments at Saturday's cross country event in Folsom. There is a Pep Band sweatshirt that will be available for students to order soon.

**Treasurer's Report** - Joyce did not have a report this month as there is nothing significant to report at this time.

### **Committee Reports** -

A. **Car Wash** (Joyce/Theresa) - The second car wash raised \$647. John has someone interested in coordinating future car washes. Maybe we can schedule a couple car washes in the spring at Nugget or somewhere similar.

B. **Davis Jazz Festival** (John) - Those involved in the planning held a meeting following the event to discuss areas of improvement for next year. We will begin planning for next year's event in March so much is done before school is out. We earned \$5,090 net in raffle sales and \$175 in water sales.

C. **Pizza and Yogurt** (Katie) - We earned \$22.13 at Baskin Robbins.

D. **Direct Donations** (Joyce/Kathryn) - \$7,281 has been collected for the "Music to Your Ears" Campaign so far. Mr. Lange would like names of the donors for the concert programs by Friday.

E. **Rent-a-Band** (Maki) - Flyers about Rent-a-Band will be distributed in the concert programs next week. Field trip forms and parent forms will be sent home with students next week. Parents must drive to and from Rent-a-Band events. Student directors have been selected. A Rent-a-Band group may perform at the Farmer's Market to promote this fundraiser.

F. **Play-a-Thon** (Sandra) - There is a mold problem in the MPR so that room is currently not available. We may be using Emerson or Harper MPR if needed.

G. **Coconut Grove** (John) - This event will also need to be held in a place other than the DHS MPR. November 18<sup>th</sup> will be the first planning meeting at John Horn's home. John will be ensuring that the sub-committees are doing their work. An event coordinator is still needed. Since the MPR is being cleaned out, all of our Coconut Grove decorations need to be removed and stored somewhere else. Lynne Rumery will provide John Horn with information on storage rental.

H. **Concerts, CD/DVD Sales** - John reports that Tom Estes is not available for recording Monday's concert. John is working out a way to have the performance recorded. John will find someone to MC at the Monday evening concert as he will be out of town. Tom will be available for all other performances. (New information: Tom is available to tape the concert on 11/15. Details being worked out between Tom & DMA). Michael George has offered to coordinate the sales of CDs and DVDs. Someone is needed to photograph next week's concerts (Wes Young). Joyce Boulanger will need submissions for December newsletter sooner.

I. **Victoria Spring Trip** (Katie) - The trip has been approved by DJUSD. A letter will be sent home to all students with the preliminary itinerary and installment schedule. We are highly motivated to make the trip as inexpensive as possible. We will be staying at a hotel downtown near the harbor and will be able to walk most places in Victoria. We may be performing at Butchart Gardens. We will frequently update families regarding trip details.

J. **Jazz Band Update** (David) - David and Mr. Lange have been coordinating the Delta Jazz Festival. Parent drivers will be needed. Field trip request has been submitted to the district. David should follow up with Sheila Wardrip to ensure that she is attending and DJUSD has her CPR card. Mr. Lange will be submitting an audition to Monterey. Reno Jazz Festival will be considered if they are not performing at Monterey.

K. **Scrip** (Lynne) - Nugget is making a change to how the Scrip program is organized. New cards will be made available to all. This new method will be quicker and easier for families to use. Trader Joe's doesn't have a Scrip program. Since Lynne has gotten involved in the Scrip program, we are collecting quite a bit more money. Thanks to Lynne for all her efforts!

L. **Publicity** - Jeannette Vance will be coordinating our concert publicity. If she sends her information to Wes, it can also be posted on the website.

M. **List Serve Administration** - Wes has taken over list serve administration.

#### **Old Business -**

A. **Coconut Grove Chair** - We still need someone to coordinate the Coconut Grove event.

B. **Clothing Swap** - People responded to emails about clothes available. Cliva Mee Harder has coordinated something similar at Da Vinci High. If we want to institute something similar, Cliva offered to help with that. In early spring Cliva will let families know by email and newsletter that there is a place where clothes can be donated.

#### **New Business -**

A. **DSOMA** representative, Hiram Jackson, shared that the school board has met to evaluate the school budget. There are several things being considered to cut from the 2011-2012 school year including eliminating a 7<sup>th</sup> period. This would greatly impact the music program as students would have less time for electives. The DJUSD deficit is predicted to be between \$3 and \$7 million. Parcel taxes are being considered. Hiram will be sending a letter on behalf of DSOMA and Band Boosters and the music program generally. He encourages us to consider adding our voices on this topic to the school board. Changes will affect nearly 2,000 families with students involved in music programs. Those present agreed it would be a great idea to have the letter be from DSOMA and Band Boosters.

B. **Repetitive Stress Injuries Speaker** - Arrangements are being made to have a medical professional come talk with students about repetitive stress disorders and their prevention through the Alexander Technique and treatment. The cost will be shared with orchestra. A motion was made to contribute \$175-\$250 towards sharing the cost with orchestra for having someone come talk to students about repetitive stress injuries. It was seconded, then unanimously approved.

Our next Band Booster meeting is scheduled for December 1, 2010.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:54 p.m.

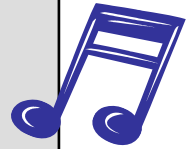
