

She led the band with gusto and offered words of encouragement to our students to keep music a part of their lives regardless of their chosen field of study.

Parents, thank you all for your help. It takes many hands to put on an event like this and I appreciate each and every one of you for your willingness to participate. It is no wonder we have such involved kids—just look at the parents!

I would like to especially thank my wonderful co-coordinators. Luci SchmidI, with her team of check-in volunteers, handled the daunting task of keeping track of permission slips and the times that students were allowed to leave. She also recorded the incoming donations and made sure each student was credited with the correct amount. Lynne Rumery solicited donations from local businesses and organized the food that kept our students going throughout the evening. Jeanette Vance handled the publicity, as well as helping with much of the organization in preparation to take over the leadership of the Play-a-Thon next year.


Thank you **Mr. Lange** for allowing this event to take place, for giving up your weekend to make it happen, and for giving the students the skills required to perform as well as they do.

I. Approval of Minutes -

The December 1st meeting minutes as printed in the January newsletter were unanimously approved.

II. Music Director's Report -



Mr. Lange complimented Joyce B. on the excellent job with the December newsletter. The Jazz Band came in first in their division in the Delta Jazz Festival. The kids have sent in their recording for the Monterey Jazz Festival. We had a wonderful Winter Concert. The Concert Band was superb, and the Symphonic Band played well. Christine Chu gave an excellent solo performance. Upcoming events include the Play-a-Thon, Festivity of Bands, Coconut Grove, and adjudicated performances. We will not attend the Folsom Jazz Festival. The Jazz Band will not be performing with the Jazz Choir Cabaret, but a combo will.

III. Student Report -

There are 6 basketball games scheduled for Pep Band, dates to be announced soon. Check the calendar.

IV. Treasurer's Report -

Joyce H. thanked all who have submitted their initial installments for the band trip. We are in good financial position for our trip. We have almost \$16,000 in reserves. We would like to maintain that cushion for years when fundraising may not be so successful.

V. Committee Reports -

A. Direct Donations - Another \$4,500 came in, making the total collected well over \$16,000.

B. <u>Rent-a-Band</u> - Maki submitted a report to John, as she was unable to attend the meeting. Rent-a-Band performed 15 gigs with 6 student leaders and 27 additional members of the band participating. Additionally, Rent-a-Band performed on "Good Morning Sacramento" on Dec. 7th. Rent-a-Band total income was \$1,520.00, and expected profits after copying expenses and purchase of breakfast items are \$1,456.08.

C. **Pizza and Yogurt** - Nothing new to report. Check the calendar for upcoming pizza dates.

D. <u>Play-a-Thon</u> - Sandra announced the event will be held at Emerson Jr. High. Students play at this fundraiser from 7 pm -7 am and collect donations from sponsors in advance. Permission forms were sent out with students and are due in the box in the band room now. Chaperones are needed throughout the night. Parents are needed to help with different tasks like delivering coffee or bringing food. An announcement, along with the forms, will go out on the listserve in a week or so. Wes will add the date to the calendar and post forms on the website.

E. <u>Coconut Grove</u> - This is our largest fundraiser for the trip student accounting, a great program for students to participate in, and a community program where bands from throughout Davis perform. John said the planning meeting will be held Jan 6th at 7:30 in the band room. There are several people willing to coordinate teams on small segments of the event. Someone must step up to serve as chair. John does not have the time to chair this event. The location has been changed to Emerson Jr. High MPR. All new decorations will be purchased for the event this year as the old ones stored in the DHS MPR were ruined by mold. (Since the meeting, Karen Clementi has offered to chair the event).

F. <u>Concerts, CD/DVD Sales</u> - Mr. Lange received the CDs and DVDs from Winter Concert. There were 37 DVDs and 27 CDs ordered. Tom did a really nice job on the covers. Sue and Jo were great helpers with sales.

G. Jazz Band Update - Mr. Lange asked David to confirm a date with the Capital Jazz Project for a spring concert. The Jazz Band took first place in the Delta Jazz Festival even without a baritone saxophone player, who had an emergency appendectomy.

H. <u>Victoria Spring Trip</u> - Katie is in the process of arranging flights. The second installment of \$200 is due January 21st. Chaperones are requested to submit their \$250 initial installment at this time. John Horn will be sending out an individual accounting to each student before the second installment is due.

I. <u>Scrip</u> - Lynne has new Nugget Scrip cards available for distribution. Another \$137 check came in. Lynne is thinking of mailing cards to alumni. She wants to investigate Target's program connected to their Target credit card. She decided not to continue with the Costco Scrip program as it was too complicated.

VI. Old Business -

VII. New Business -

A. **Reno Jazz Festival** is April 8-10, the last weekend of our spring break. This conflicts with the Jazz Choir trip to New York. Joyce B. and Wes Y. requested an updated calendar from Mr. Lange.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:13 p.m.
