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## Band Booster Minutes ~ November 9, 2011 4

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m.
- 2. <u>Approval of Minutes</u> The October meeting minutes as published in the November Band Boosters newsletter were unanimously approved.



- 3. <u>Music Director's Report</u> Mr. Lange shared that last Sunday select members of the Symphonic Band participated in the Sister City Concert. Coming up is the concert, "Lest We Forget," honoring people who served in the military. Friday evening the Jazz Band will perform with guest artist Mary Fettig. That evening we will also honor Celia Cottle. People are encouraged to email John Horn with thoughts to share about her. Symphonic Band will have a very important rehearsal this Sunday evening prior to the concert beginning at 7:00 p.m. Mr. Quick says the Concert Band is preparing for the Winter Rhapsody. Band families are encouraged to invite their friends and family to attend these performances.
- Student Report Mr. Quick said that the football season was great. The senior students were announced at the senior game. The band is now preparing for basketball season. For those who pre-ordered Pep Band sweatshirts they are \$25.00, payable to Band Boosters, and will be available the beginning of December.
- 5. <u>Treasurer's Report</u> There is \$43,000 in the Band Boosters accounts: savings has \$15,735.92; checking has \$27,243.31 (General \$17,299.37, Music Fund \$1,559.68, IPAB Fund \$3,132.50, Student Accounting \$5, 251.76). Direct Donation Campaign \$5,780 to date, Other Donations equal \$1,577, Car Wash \$930. The 30 students who worked at the car wash earned \$13.73/hour in credits, Davis Jazz & Beat Festival raffle around \$2,900. Several students worked really hard to sell tickets at the event bringing in another \$617. Students at the ticket booth and performers earned a total of \$470 in credits.
- 6. Committee Reports
  - A. <u>Car Wash</u> The last car wash was extended to 6 hours. John has already sent out the request for car wash dates for next school year. We need a place to store car wash supplies until next year. If you are willing to hold it until next year, please contact John Horn.
  - B. <u>Davis Jazz Festival</u> The Jazz Band played very well and it was a beautiful afternoon. The position of the stage allowed for more shade. Natsoulas did all the set up. We had minimal involvement in the event which was great.
  - C. <u>Pizza & Yogurt Fundraisers</u> No report. If anyone is interested in talking to Lamppost, Woodstock's, Yoloberry, Baskin Robbins, or The Grad to arrange fundraising, please contact John Horn. Jill Theg is willing to contact Cultive to see if they will work with us.
  - D. <u>Direct Donations</u> The letter has been sent out and donations are coming in. Donors will be listed in the concert brochures. This fundraiser will be announced at the concert. Donations are to be collected through November 18<sup>th</sup>.
  - E. <u>Rent-A-Band</u> The first rehearsal was held Wednesday, November 8<sup>th</sup>. Maki will send out a special announcement and flyer in the next newsletter. If you are having a holiday party, or know someone having a party, consider hiring a group to perform. Permission slips are being collected and parent drivers are needed for carpools.
  - F. January Fundraiser Katie Horn sent out a survey to students about Play-A-Thon. About a third of the band, or 55 students, responded. The majority of those responding had fun and liked the dancing, eating, and staying up all night with friends. Less fun was the seriousness of the college student conductors from UOP. We are considering having no evening or morning concert. There may be different happenings during each hour, like students conducting, playing Pep Band music or circus music, or using different instruments. We are also looking into a Bowl-A-Thon at MU. Maybe the long weekend date is not convenient for families.
  - G. <u>Coconut Grove</u> Sue Ebeler says the committee met. There are a good group of people helping with the activities. Help is still needed with food and silent auction. All committees need parents of students (not seniors) to assist. Please consider donating a string of white lights for the event. The next meeting will be Thursday, November 17<sup>th</sup>, at 7:30 p.m.
  - H. <u>Concerts, CD/DVD Sales</u> Michael George has been contacted to come for Monday's concert. Sales will be available for one week after each concert. Order forms will be available in the band room for last minute orders. John will talk to Michael George about having an order form after concerts and in the band room.
  - <u>San Diego Spring Trip</u> Busses, hotel, and concert venues are confirmed. The trip itinerary may include a tour of UC San Diego, and a BBQ. A bright orange paper was sent home with students. Please return by December 5<sup>th</sup> with deposit. It will be sent out on the listserv. Sea World is quite expensive, so we are deciding whether or not to go there.
  - J. <u>New Orleans Jazz Band Trip</u> John Horn requested all Jazz Band parents to stay after the meeting to get more details about the trip to New Orleans.
  - K. <u>Scrip</u> Nothing new to report.
