San Diego Band Spring trip May 14-18, 2015: Trip planning will conclude with the final chaperone's meeting tonight. Final logistics set. We are still waiting for some final payments and trip forms to be completed. Most meals will be provided, though there are a couple of times the students will need to buy their own meals. The "Wind Ensemble" (i.e., members of the Concert, Symphonic and Jazz Bands) will play every day. The Jazz Band will play two of the three times and the Pep Band will play once. There is a parent/pediatrician accompanying the trip this year. The planning committee is seeking an alternative activity for those with severe nut allergies for the event at the Padre's game.

The DHS Band Boosters is seeking board officers for next year, including Treasurer, Secretary, and someone to shadow or serve as Co-President for next year taking over the following year. Also seeking committee chairs interested in taking on Coconut Grove, Monticello wine & cheese event, possibly new event, the Big Day of Giving. Activities this summer would include materials purchasing for silent auction and preparation for the first fall events. John is interested in holding a gathering of community members and band parents in the fall, perhaps a spaghetti feed. We won't do a car wash again. Possibly do a "fill the bucket" event instead. John will send out a Signup Genius listing all of the committee and board member positions that need filling.

Next meeting will invite junior high parents to join and encourage them to get involved and sign up for activities.

We will hold an end of year celebration for the Jazz Band. The time and date are not yet set.
