

# FOLSOM JAZZ FESTIVAL INFORMATION SHEET

January 27, 2018

## GENERAL INFORMATION AND OVERVIEW

The Folsom Jazz Festival is an adjudicated performance where jazz bands and choirs from around the state come to perform, receive ranked placement, and are provided a clinic following their performance by one of the adjudicators. In addition, this festival also has a division for Jazz Combos, and we will have three combos performing in the High School Division.

In the Jazz Band division, there are a total of four divisions: Elementary, Middle School, High School, and College. Within the High School Class, there are six classifications, listed by school enrollment: C, B, A, AA, AAA, AAAA. Davis will perform in the High School – AA class.

In the Combo division, there is only a High School division, with four Combo classes (I don't know the criteria for classification): A, B, C, and D. All two Davis Combos will perform in the B class.

Due to the addition of combo performances for our school, we will have four performances of ensembles throughout the day. As such, we will be staying through the final combo performance and departing immediately after the conclusion of the combo clinic.

**Special Note** – All students are expected to stay for the entire festival. Any early departures/late arrivals **MUST** be preplanned with Mr. Slabaugh well in advance of the event. Transportation, chaperone, and liability issues preclude any last-minute changes to the schedule.

**Parents:** We are in need of both chaperones and drivers for this event. Please go to the DHS Band Booster web site to obtain the DJUSD paperwork that must be completed so you may drive students to this event. Please complete this paperwork immediately and send to Mr. Slabaugh so he can submit it to the front office.

## BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS OF ALL STUDENTS

1. All school rules are in effect from the time of departure from DHS to our return to DHS after the conclusion of the entire event.
2. Students will follow the directions/instructions of chaperones and school officials at all times.
3. All students will meet at pre-designated meet locations on time and with all necessary performance items, including attire, instruments, sheet music, and equipment.
4. All students will, unless noted otherwise, attend every DHS performance and clinic.
5. **NO STUDENT MAY DRIVE THEMSELVES TO OR FROM THIS EVENT.** All students **MUST** ride with a DJUSD approved driver.

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**TRAVEL DIRECTIONS** Folsom High School is located at **1655 Iron Point Road, Folsom CA.**

- Take I-80 East. (4.6 miles, ~10 minutes) • Keep heading East until I-80 becomes US-50 East. Exit at Prairie City Road (exit 25) in Sacramento County. (31.8 miles, ~ 30 minutes)
- Continue on Prairie City Road to Iron Point Road in Folsom. (1.0 miles, ~2 minutes)

**THE ESTIMATED TRAVEL TIME IS 40 MINUTES VIA GOOGLE MAPS. PLEASE TAKE YOUR TIME AS THE WEATHER MAY BE WET OR FOGGY ALONG I-80 AND US-50.**

**TRAVEL IN A CARAVAN IN CASE A VEHICLE BREAKS DOWN, ANOTHER VEHICLE WILL BE ABLE TO PICK UP THE BAND MEMBERS AND TAKE THEM TO THE EVENT. MEET LOCATIONS AT FOLSOM HIGH SCHOOL** For the first performance (Big Band) of the day, we will meet outside the **Folsom High School Theater** 10 minutes prior to our “Enter Warm-up Room” scheduled time. All members need to have all their instruments/equipment and sheet music at this meet time.

For the remaining three combo performances, we will meet at Rolling Hills Christian Church.

## SCHEDULE

Davis High School

- Meet in room **PA-3** at **7:20am**. Please have all of your uniform items, sheet music, and instruments/equipment. Please wear your uniform items as you enter the band room.
- Depart DHS at **7:45am**. Please follow cars in a caravan so if there is a car breakdown, we are able to pick up the student(s) in other cars and arrive at the festival on time.
- We will exchange phone numbers of all the drivers prior to departure. Estimated Arrival Time: **~8:30am**. Everyone needs to meet outside the **Folsom High School Theater immediately upon arrival**. Band members: Please wear your complete concert attire, including tie, shirt tucked in, etc... Mr. Slabaugh will check in the ensembles at the festival office, distribute wristbands to students, and make any necessary changes to the schedule that may have occurred.

Parents: During the band check-in time, you may purchase admission passes to the festival.

## **Davis Jazz Ensemble (Full Band)**

- Meet outside the **Folsom High School Theater** at 8:30am
- Enter Warm-up Room (Gym) at ~9:00am
- Performance in the **Folsom High School Theater** at 9:40am
- Clinic in classroom following the performance.

Following the **Full Band** performance, we will stay and listen to other performing bands. Chaperones: Please stay with your students throughout the day. No one is allowed to leave the Folsom High School campus.

**EVERY DHS STUDENT WILL BE IN ATTENDANCE FOR EVERY DHS COMBO PERFORMANCE. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

- Enter Warm-up Room at ~2:50pm

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- Performance at 3:20pm in the FHS Library
- Clinic in TBD location

After the conclusion of the final performance, we will caravan back to Davis High School. If parents are only driving their own child, they may check out with Mr. Slabaugh and head directly home. I estimate our arrival time in Davis at ~4:30pm. We will unload school owned equipment into PA-3 before heading home from the performance.
