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**Davis High School Band Program Student Trip Behavior Expectations**

**Both a Parent and Student Signature is Required Below. This must be returned to Mr. Slabaugh before departure to Reno.**

The DHS Band Program has enjoyed a history of good behavior on trips. Students are seen as representatives of Davis Senior High School, the City of Davis, and the U.S. The director and chaperones expect all students to respect and follow the behavioral expectations listed below:

1. Each student shall respect and obey the directions of the Directors and all chaperones.
2. When the group is at the hotel, you **MUST** stay on the hotel grounds. If you need to leave for **ANY** reason, a chaperone must accompany you. Do not go anywhere by yourself.
3. Students shall stay in chaperone groups when away from the hotel, and shall know and strictly adhere to all timelines, itineraries, and curfews.
4. Students will only enter their hotel room registered to the DHS Band. Do not open your hotel door without first checking to see who is there. Doors must be opened immediately if a chaperone knocks.
5. Only those assigned to the hotel room may be in that room at any given time. No student or outside visitors are allowed in the hotel rooms. Once you are checked in for the night, you **MUST** stay in your room. No leaving for ice, lobby, etc.
6. You must have a chaperone present to hang out or swim in the pool/spa area, lobby, or rehearsal room, and during all scheduled free time and meals.
7. Students shall attend all meetings, rehearsals, and performances. Students are expected to be on time and come prepared and equipped with all appropriate materials.
8. Students shall respect the hotel property as well as the housekeeping service. Students are responsible for any damage to their hotel room. If damage occurs, the parents of the room occupants will be held accountable for the cost.
9. Students shall be respectful of other hotel guests, keeping noise to a minimum in the rooms, halls, and lobby. Students need to be considerate of their roommates, others' personal property, quiet/study times and others' sleep needs.
10. You will not be able to put charges on your room bill. Outside phone service and pay-per-view movies will be disabled. Room service is not allowed to deliver food to student rooms.
11. Students shall abide by all the rules of the Davis Joint Unified School District and the laws of the state of California.

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12. Students may not consume alcohol, tobacco, non-prescription, or non-medical drugs. The Director and the chaperones reserve the right to make periodic, unannounced checks for alcohol and/or drugs. Students shall turn in all prescription and over the counter medications at trip check-in to the Director and a designated chaperone who will dispense all medications.

13. No student shall compromise his or her own safety or the safety of any other person.

If a student chooses to disobey any of the rules listed above, the student will receive consequences as mandated by DJUSD guidelines. Depending on the severity of the infraction students can be sent home at their parents' expense and suspended from school at an appropriate time. Final decisions about consequences will be determined by DHS Administration and be expressed directly to the student and the parents.
