The purpose of the "PreDeparture Check-In Event" is to assist every tour group member/passenger to obtain clearance at all 5 "check-in" stations. We want to be absolutely certain that everyone is "Ready for Take Off" as they board the bus the following afternoon.

This process is necessary. Any potential problems need to be identified now, otherwise they could cause unnecessary delays for the entire group. As well, for the duration of the trip, we want to ensure required items are actually physically in hand or "packed" (e.g. concert clothes, music binder, medications, etc.)

Basic Overview of the Event:

Passenger begins with Station 1, signs in, has gear packed ready to be processed and collected. A Departure Card with their name is stamped and issue. Passenger continues with Stations 2 through 4, completing each with a stamp on their card.

Last Station 5, Emergency Contact is verified. Last stamp applied, and the completed departure card is collected.

 (Could use greencard or passport if no other photo ID exists but since each student must take care of their own ID, easily replaceable ID like school ID is recommended)

- Empty water bottle; label clearly with name
- □ **Students can carry the following meds on them:** epi-pen, insulin with syringe, inhalers and birth control pills.
- □ Jacket or sweatshirt/sweater (cabin can get cold)
- Wallet
 - While not required, students may want to bring some spending money for snacks/extra food or souvenirs

Recommended:

- Lip balm
- D Mobile phone and/or electronic device with charging accessories
- □ Hand wipes (or Hand sanitizer, (3-1-1 bag))
- □ Reading material
- Photocopy of ID
- □ Headphones/earbuds
- □ Tissues
- Snacks, must be wrapped no nuts

- □ Hand cream and make up(3-1-1 bag)
- □ Toothpaste (3-1-1 bag), toothbrush, floss

MEDICATION

General purpose medications like Tylenol, allergy pills will be provided by team doctors. If there is personal prescribed medications (other than the items listed in 2. Personal Carry On section above) you are bringing to the trip, they must be carried in its original container with the original labels. This rule applies to over the counter medications. These medications must be checked in during the pre-departure check-in at Station 4.

FOR THE FLIGHT

Wear orchestra/band School Tour Shirt and comfortable pants and shoes. Avoid wearing a belt; you will need to remove it while passing through security. Do not wear expensive or excessive jewelry.
