- Rehearsal at the Band of the Golden West Music Hall, Travis AFB, CA on April 13, 2019 at 10am
- Performance at The Vacaville Performing Arts Theater, Vacaville CA on April 14, 2019 at 3pm

Applicants are responsible for travel arrangements/expenses to and from the scheduled rehearsal and performance

How to apply:

- Digitally submit audition package by February 1, 2019 to: USAFCommandersJazzEnsemble@gmail.com
- Include your full name, instrument, age, high school, phone number, email address, band director's name, band director's email address and city you live in
- Showcase your jazz soloing abilities by recording yourself playing with a live rhythm section, or any backing track (iRealB, Jamey Aebersold, etc.)

Instrumentalists:

- Record yourself playing the melody to any medium-tempo 12-bar blues and improvise several choruses
- Record yourself playing any standard jazz tune in a contrasting style to your blues selection, play the melody, and improvise several choruses

Drum & Bass Applicants:

• Demonstrate your ability to play time functioning in a rhythm section, as well as showing your soloist skills over a medium-tempo 12-bar blues and a standard jazz tune in a contrasting style to the blues

Vocalists:

• Sing the lyrics to a blues and a contrasting jazz standard. Improvisation abilities are optional, but highly encouraged
