Saturday, June 9, 2018 – SAN FRANCISCO → NEW YORK CITY

- 3:30pm Meet as a group at Davis Senior High School.
Load the coaches and transfer to San Francisco International Airport (SFO).
- 6:30pm Arrive at SFO at least 2.5 hours prior to your flight.
Check-in to your flight and proceed through security and on to your departure gate.
- 9:05pm Depart SFO for John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK) on Jet Blue flight #916.
Overnight en route.

DAY ONE: Sunday, June 10, 2018 – NEW YORK CITY (B, D) – Rehearsals and/or Workshops

- 5:43am Arrive into JFK. A World Projects Festival Staff Member will meet you in baggage to assist in collecting luggage.
Load the coaches transfer to Hard Rock Café for a group breakfast.
After breakfast transfer to the Festival hotel.
You will be met at the hotel by a World Projects staff member, who will assist with baggage storage.
Once baggage is stored the symphony orchestra and symphonic band will each have a **rehearsal** and/or group **workshop** with a Festival clinician.
(The symphony orchestra and symphonic band are each allocated a maximum of 2 hours' rehearsal time. Each ensemble has the option to divide that time between one (1) 60-minute rehearsal and one (1) 60-minute workshop.)
- Afternoon Later, the group will store instruments and have lunch on own in the Times Square area.
By 4:00pm Return to the hotel to retrieve baggage and instruments from storage and check-in to rooms. The group will have time to freshen up before meeting in the lobby to go to dinner as a group.
- 4:45pm Dinner as a group at the Bubba Gump Shrimp Co.
After dinner walk to the Winter Garden Theatre.
- 7:00pm Enjoy the Broadway show *School of Rock*.
After the show, return to the hotel.



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DAY TWO: Monday, June 11, 2018 – NEW YORK CITY (B, D) – Workshop (Jazz Band) & Performances

7:30am Breakfast as a group at Applebee's.
 Jazz Band assemble, load coaches and transfer to workshop location (TBD – Possibly Lincoln Center or a local studio.)
 Enjoy a 60-minute *workshop* with a local jazz clinician (TBD).
 Load the coaches and return to the hotel.

Afternoon Lunch on own in the area.
 Meet in the lobby and load the coaches with instruments. Transfer to either Liberty Science Center or Central Park for your public performance.
 Each ensemble will enjoy a *public performance* at either Liberty Science Center or the Central Park band shell (public performance venue is based on availability at time of booking).
 After your performances, return to the hotel.

Evening Meet in the lobby and load the coaches for the Festival Dinner Cruise!
 Eat, dance to DJ music, and enjoy the sights (including a stunning view of the Statue of Liberty) as you cruise along the Hudson River with other Festival participants. Following the cruise, load coaches and return to the hotel.



DAY THREE: Tuesday, June 12, 2018 – NEW YORK CITY (B) – Carnegie Hall Performances

7:30am Breakfast as a group at Applebee's.
 After breakfast, walk to the Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts.

10:00am Enjoy a guided tour of Lincoln Center.
Learn more about Lincoln Center's iconic landmarks—including the Revson Fountain, the newly transformed Alice Tully Hall, and the Metropolitan Opera House.
 Load coaches and return to the hotel.

Afternoon Lunch on own in the Times Square area
 Assemble in the lobby of the hotel in performance attire with instruments and depart on foot for Carnegie Hall.
 Arrive at Carnegie Hall where each ensemble will enjoy a sound check. Secure instruments in your warm up areas.

Evening Enjoy dinner on your own in the Times Square area or nearby.
 Arrive back at Carnegie Hall for the **Evening Concert** in the Isaac Stern Auditorium! Following the concert is the Awards Ceremony.
 Afterwards, collect your belongings and return to the hotel.



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DAY FOUR: Wednesday, June 13, 2018 – NEW YORK CITY (B,D)

7:30am Breakfast as a group at Applebee's.
Assemble in the lobby and depart on a guided tour of lower Manhattan which will include a ferry ride by the Statue of Liberty, and visits to Ellis Island, the 9/11 Memorial and Museum (TBC).

Afternoon Lunch on own during the tour. After the tour return to the hotel with time to freshen up for this evening's activities.

Evening Meet in the lobby and walk to dinner.
5:30pm Dinner as a group at John's Pizzeria (TBC).
After dinner, walk to Rockefeller Center.

8:00pm Enjoy the scenic view of NYC from the "Top of the Rock".
Later, return to the hotel.



DAY FIVE: Thursday, June 14, 2018 – NEW YORK CITY → HOME (B)

7:30am Breakfast as a group at Applebee's.
Check-out of hotel and store baggage in designated location (TBC).
Assemble in the lobby, walk to the Museum of Modern Art.
Enjoy the wonderful art pieces found in the MOMA.

Afternoon Lunch on own in the cafeteria at MOMA.
Return to the hotel to collect all baggage.

2:00pm Load coaches and transfer to Newark Liberty International Airport.

By 3:00pm Upon arrival, check-in for your flight, pass through security and on to your departure gate.

5:30pm Depart for SFO on United Airlines flight #1584.
9:08pm Arrive into SFO. Head to baggage claim to collect your luggage.

United Airlines Group 2 (75 seats)

6:30pm Depart for SFO on United Airlines flight #748.
9:45pm Arrive into SFO. Head to baggage claim to collect your luggage and meet the rest of the group.

All Travelers

Meet the coaches with your luggage and transfer to Davis Senior High School.
Upon arrival, transfer home via your own transportation.

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Package Inclusions

- ◆ ACTUAL roundtrip, economy class airfare on Jet Blue and United Airlines (SFO-JFK, EWR-SFO) including estimated taxes/fuel surcharge (*subject to change*)
- ◆ First checked bag fee (to the value of \$25 per person on United Airlines subject to height and weight restrictions – Jet Blue does not charge a 1st bag fee)

Notes:

- **Air:** ACTUAL roundtrip, economy class airfare on Jet Blue and United Airlines has been included in this package. A total of 142 seats. The base fare is guaranteed while taxes and fees are subject to change until ticketing. The United Airline seats are 100% refundable until January 15, 2018. After January 15, 2018, 90% of the seats held must be utilized to avoid a penalty. The Jet Blue seats are non-refundable and deposits on seats that do not get utilized will be lost.
- **Baggage:** Baggage fees are set by Jet Blue and United Airlines. The first checked bag for each traveler has been included in the above costs (to the value of \$25 per person on United Airlines subject to height and weight restrictions – Jet Blue does not charge a 1st bag fee). In addition to this, a fund of \$3,500 has been included to be put towards 2nd checked, overweight, and/or oversized baggage. Any additional charges for oversized/overweight baggage in excess of this amount will be the responsibility of Davis Senior High School at the time of airport check-in.
- **Air Reduction:** Available to all travelers for the return flight only. All travelers are required to fly with the group on the outbound to New York. Travelers taking the air reduction are responsible for their own return flight arrangements, return luggage costs, return ground transportation, and hotel accommodations after the festival should their flight schedule not correspond with the group flight schedule.
- **Rooming:** Quad denotes four (4) people per room, two double beds per room. Triple denotes three (3) people per room, two double beds per room. Sharing beds for quad and triple occupancy will be necessary. Double or single occupancy rooms could have two double beds, one queen size, or one king size bed in the room. Hotel rooms will be held on a “first come — first served” basis.
- **Gratis:** Gratis is based on one (1) single package rate and two (2) double package rates.
- **Payment:** All payments must be made by school check, bank check or cash – credit cards will not be accepted.
- **Numbers:** World Projects reserves the right to re-cost this proposal should the numbers fall above or below the number of participants shown above. Please note that the New York Sounds of Summer International Music Festival requires a minimum of 120 travelers for the group to have two performance slots at Carnegie Hall. This minimum may be reached by including all travelers including performers, staff, and chaperones/adults.
- **Student Protection Plan:** World Projects will purchase a Student Protection Plan (post departure) for all travelers. The director will be sent details about the plan.
- **Agreement:** Once the tour has been deposited on, World Projects will issue a Performance Agreement detailing the costs, inclusion/exclusions, payment and cancellation schedule, and terms of the tour proposal for the director to sign.
- **Required Forms:** All travelers will be required to submit signed liability waivers and medical authorizations forms as issued by World Projects to participate in the festival.
