The HBAC was a collaboration between the California Department of Boating and Waterways (DBW), the City of Eureka, and Humboldt State University.

What is the HBAC used for?

The HBAC is currently being used for a variety of classes, meetings, conferences and HSU boating equipment storage. Look for Boating Safety Classes, Center Activities Leisure Classes and construction of a new floating dock facility soon.

Who can use the facility?

The facility offers a variety of rooms to be rented by the HSU campus and community organizations for meetings, trainings, conferences, and social events.

Limited aquatic equipment rentals are available through Center Activities and may be picked up at the HBAC. Call 707.826.3357 to rent equipment today!



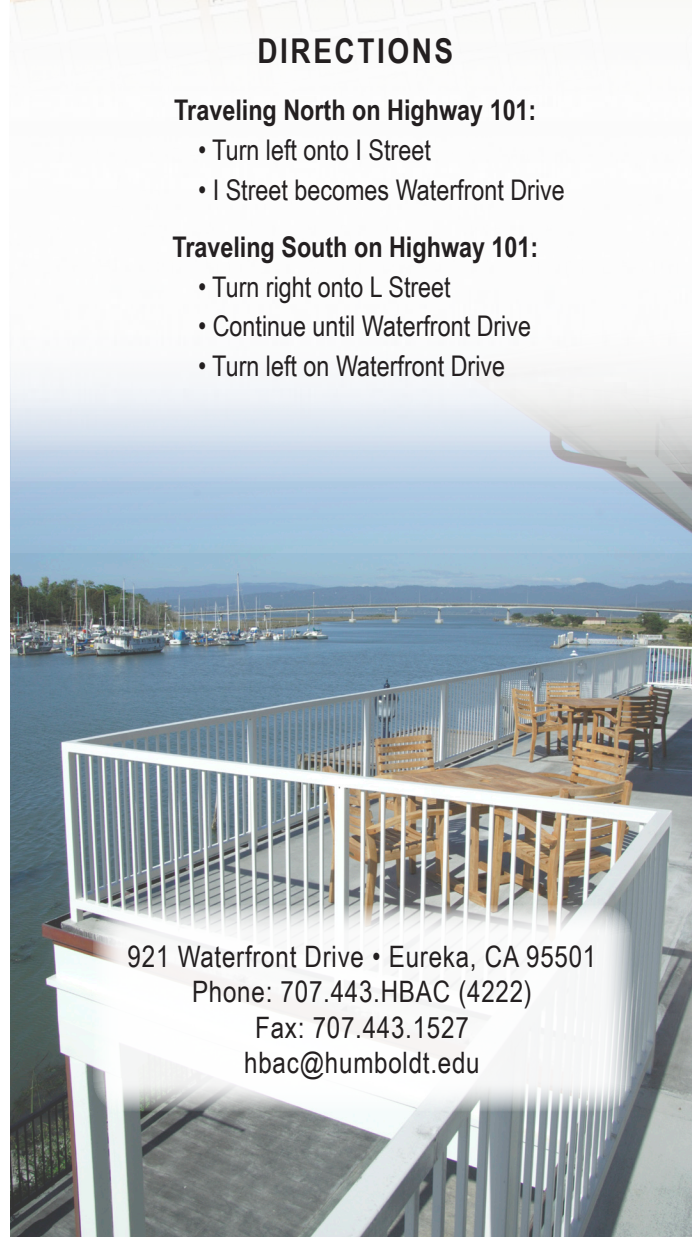
DIRECTIONS

A Center Activities Program



The Humboldt Bay Aquatic Center (HBAC) is an exciting new Humboldt State University facility. It is located on the beautiful Eureka Waterfront next to the Adorni Center. The HBAC is managed by HSU Center Activities and is open to the public.

This facility was designed to serve HSU Students, HSU Organizations, and the local community. Some facility uses include:

- Boating Safety and Recreation Courses
- Center Activities Leisure Classes and Aquatic Courses
- HSU Crew Team Training Facility
- University Activities (i.e. Extended Education Classes)
- HSU Boat Storage Area

The facility contains: three classrooms, two conference rooms, one common room with adjoining kitchen, a training space for the HSU Crew Team, and a boat storage area.



The classroom to the right features balcony access and a sound-proof dividing door. This option allows the space to be divided into two classrooms while offering privacy to each group.
