The 2000 Record of Decision directs implementation of a coarse sediment augmentation program below Lewiston Dam. This activity replaces the coarse sediment trapped behind the dams and balances the coarse sediment transported during high-flow releases.

This workshop will be a technical presentation that offers the opportunity to learn about where the Trinity River sediment management strategy started, what methods have changed and evolved, and what has been learned over the last 15 years through adaptive management. Sediment management science continues to evolve; join us to learn where it will lead into the future.
